
CERTIFICATE IN RESPECT OF A BY-LAW

METROPOLITAN TORONTO CONDOMINIUM CORPORATION NO. 600

BY-LAW NO. 10

BE IT ENACTED as a By-law of Metropolitan Toronto Condominium Corporation No. 600 (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") as follows:


- (i) A meeting of the board may be held by way of teleconference or any other form of communication that allows the directors to participate concurrently provided that all of directors participating in a meeting held by such means consent thereto.
- (ii) Each director may by written consent agree in advance to future meetings being conducted in the aforesaid manner without the necessity of consenting prior to each meeting provided that such consent will automatically be revoked for any meeting for which a director provides written notice revoking his or her consent.
